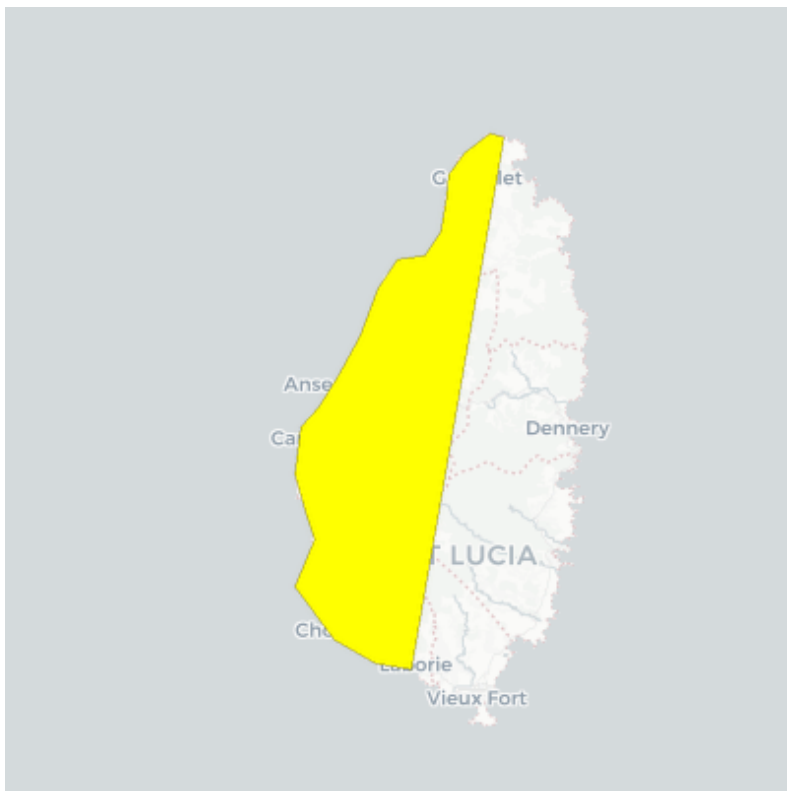

Description:

An extremely active tropical wave is expected to bring frequent heavy rain, with active thunderstorms and gusty winds to Saint Lucia tonight. There is a moderate risk of rainfall intensities between 25 to 40 mm/h in localized downpours. Rainfall of this intensity can cause surface and/or flash flooding, especially in areas such as Bexon, Soufriere, and Castries Town and their vicinity and other low-lying areas such as streams, rivers or narrow valleys, and may also lead to slips in the vicinity. Strong winds and lightning can affect the electricity grid. Impact: Ponds, streams and canals may rise rapidly. Surface

flooding, rock fall, landslips, and difficult driving conditions possible. Commute times will be longer. Electricity power outage possible.

Instruction:

Take measures to reduce potential flood damage. Clear your drains and gutters to prepare for heavy rain. Avoid low-lying areas and drive cautiously. Prepare for possible power outages. Residents are advised to keep up to date with the latest Warnings and Watches and check for additions and upgrades from the SLMS
